

Why is deadly tucker important for bub after a burn?

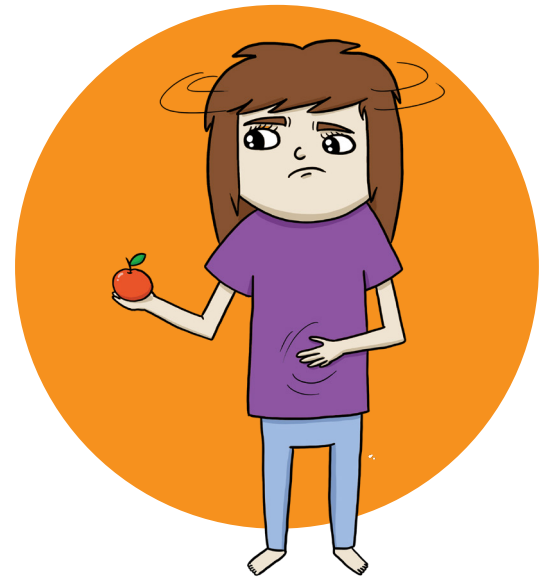
Eating deadly tucker reduces the risk of infection and helps wounds and sores heal faster.

Why bub might not be hungry?

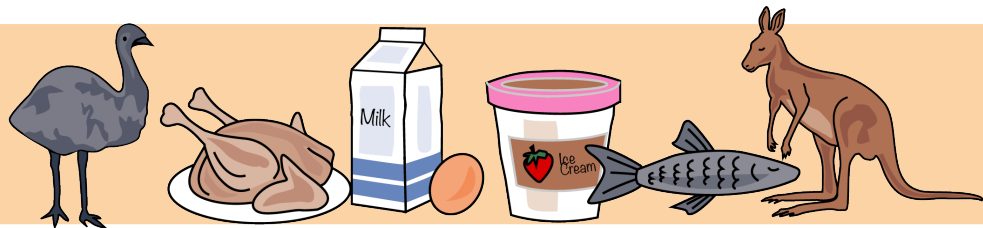
- Tired from the medication
